Tending to accident victims

Tending to an accident victim means:

- Calm them down;
- perform some first aid.

What can we do to help?



- remove any airway obstructions;
- if the victim is unconscious, draw their head back and raise the chin;
- place the victim in the recovery position.





You must only perform first aid **if you have** the necessary skills!

What we mustn't do

Above all we must avoid:

- running risks and acting impulsively with no precautions;
- creating chaos and confusion around the victim.

Furthermore we must not:

- lift up the victim or make the victim get up:
- move the victim from where he is, unless there is serious and imminent danger;
- place a cushion under the victim's head;
- remove his helmet unless he is able to do so himself;
- give him anything to drink.
